Streaming Implementation Guidelines for the Transdisciplinary Program of the College of Education, National Taiwan Normal University

Applicable for Admission in Academic Year 2021

- 1. To help students develop diverse professional capabilities and apply the principles of postponing the streaming for the Transdisciplinary Program of the College of Education (hereinafter referred to as the Program) at the National Taiwan Normal University, the University has established the "Streaming Implementation Guidelines for the Transdisciplinary Program of the College of Education, National Taiwan Normal University" (referred to as the Streaming Implementation Guidelines).
- 2. The departments (Bachelor's Program) with streaming as specified by the Streaming Implementation Guidelines include the Department of Education, Department of Education Psychology and Counseling, Department of Adult and Continuing Education, Department of Health Promotion and Health Education, Department of Human Development and Family Studies, Department of Civic Education and Leadership, and the Program of Learning Sciences, a total of six departments and one bachelor's degree program. For details of the principles of streaming and enrollment, please refer to the supplementary provisions of the Streaming Implementation Guidelines.
- 3. Every year, the number of students in the Program that will be streamed to each department (Bachelor's Program) will be announced on the Program's website.
- 4. The students in the Program can apply for streaming at two different points in time, either in the 1st or the 2nd semester of the second academic year. The timetable for the streaming application is subject to the Program's actual announcement.
- 5. The streaming application is carried out via the following procedures:
 - (1) Students must follow the rules of the "Study Guidelines for the Transdisciplinary Program of the College of Education, National Taiwan Normal University" to complete the required courses of the Program and at least one introductory course from each of at least three departments (Bachelor's Program) before they become eligible to apply for streaming.
 - (2) Students need to fill in the streaming wish form in the Program's streaming application system according to the announced timetable and submit their transcripts of courses taken, information required by each streaming department (Bachelor's Program) and other relevant supporting documents.
 - 1. Fill in the streaming wish list based on the order of preference, and at least 3 preferences shall be filled in.
 - 2. Those who apply for the streaming during the 1st semester of the second academic year should submit their transcripts of the first academic year; those who apply for the streaming during the 2nd semester of the second academic year should submit their

transcripts of the first academic year and the 1st semester of the second academic year.

- 3. Relevant information required by each streaming department (Bachelor's Program).
- (3) The streaming process is based on the wish lists provided by the students. The Program will forward the application and information to the streaming departments (Bachelor's Program) based on the order of their preference, and each department (Bachelor's Program) will arrange the admission order.
- (4) The number of students admitted through the first streaming by each department (Bachelor's Program) shall not exceed 2/3 of the quota of the department (Bachelor's Program) for the Program. After the admission order is determined, the Program will coordinate the distribution and announcement of the admission results.
- (5) Students in the Program who wish to relinquish the first streaming for any reason can submit their request within a specific timetable, and the vacancies will be filled based on the wish order of other students.
- (6) If students from the Program cannot be successfully streamed to other departments (Bachelor's Program) through two separate streaming opportunities, the Student Class Affairs Committee will, then, help arrange the streaming before the 2nd semester of the second academic year ends.
- 6. The additional students added to the total number of enrolments in each academic year whose streaming to each department is not counted as the quota announced in Article 3 of the Streaming Implementation Guidelines.
- 7. For students who return to University after a leave of absence, the streaming is subject to the remaining unallocated quota for the year of original enrollment in the Program.
- 8. The implementation measures are formulated by the Program's Student Class Affairs Committee, then forwarded to the Curriculum Committee of the College of Education for review, and then submitted to the Academic Affairs Meetings for deliberation before implementation, and the same applies to any revision.
